Band Camp - August 6/7/8, 2019

- We will follow the school dress code during this three day camp. This means appropriate length for shorts, no tank tops or spaghetti strap shirts. All clothing should be suitable for long hours in the sun. Low-cut and see through garments are not permitted.
- Shirts and tennis shoes (no sandals or flip flops) must be worn at all times.
- Hats and Sunscreen are **strongly** recommended.
- Cell phone use will be kept to a minimum; used during breaks or in the event of an emergency. We will follow the school cell phone policy (as stated in the student handbook) during rehearsal sessions.
- **Band and Color Guard members will be fit for uniforms at camp. All members are asked to pay a small fee of \$10 to help defray the cost of dry cleaning. This fee needs to be paid during registration the first day of camp.**
- **Band and Color Guard members need to purchase a band t-shirt (\$10) and hat (\$20) prior to performance on August 8th.**
- Music Boosters will assist during rehearsals as needed, providing lunch, water, team building activities, etc... We need parent volunteers - 3 in the am and 3 in the pm. Please contact a member of the booster executive board via facebook band page.
